Worship

As disciples of Jesus, we are called into community to worship and give thanks. While our worship has an audience of One, we are blessed that our Worship Ministry team provides us with different worship times with diverse, inspiring music and thought provoking messages so that we can choose an experience that we find personally most worshipful. Opportunities are also made available to worship and express our love for Jesus through singing in the choir, playing an instrument, playing the handbells, drama, dancing or reading scripture.

In addition to our Sunday Children's message, children 4-7 years old participate in Children's Worship. On Wednesday nights, children of all ages worship and learn together. Festival Sundays, children's choirs, and services led by our youth enhance multi-generational worship and help us fulfill our call to pass our faith to the next generations.

Congregational Care

Providing care for a church family as large and diverse as ours, is no small feat. Our Congregational Care Ministry team oversees the nurture, support and fellowship of our church family. They emulate the character of Jesus through a supportive, loving and caring ministry to and with one another, especially in times of need.

Our deacons are the hands and feet of Christ ministering to those who are in need, are sick, are lonely or who may be in distress; within our church family or beyond. Deacons also distribute home communion, and provide support for families during times of loss with funerals. This ministry also helps build community, facilitating fellowship events, dinners and more. Reaching out to the community, the team supports Families Anonymous, Grief Share and more.

Budget: \$327,289

\$.24 of each dollar we give supports our Congregational Care Ministries.

Whether we are serving food, collecting needed clothing or supplies, putting up drywall, sewing quilts or tutoring a child, we know how to share our gifts of time, talent and treasure with our 20+ local mission partners. When doing so, our lives are transformed when we serve in His name.

We reach our neighbors far from home through multiple service mission trips annually for people of all ages and by financially supporting ministries and missionaries with whom we share aligned missions and visions.

Christian Education

An essential role of the church is to foster and facilitate the faith formation of our church family and our community.
